

1. SCOPE

MS Australia set a strategic priority to embed people with MS, their carers, family and friends within the organisation.

Pillar 3 of MS Australia's Strategic Plan 2022-2026, *People living with MS, their carers, friends and family*, sets a strategic priority to ensure the MS community has a strong voice in our governance, research, policy and advocacy, education and awareness.

MS Australia is developing a strategy that specifically focuses on the needs, wellbeing and voice of people affected by MS through our Consumer Engagement Roadmap, family, friends and those caring for a people with MS (carers).

Carers are an integral part of the care economy and act as the foundation for our aged, disability, palliative and community care systems. Their contribution often remains unrecognised. Similarly, their diverse needs are often overlooked.


MS Australia will prioritise carers by developing a project specifically focussing on carers to improve their wellbeing and quality of life. MS Australia aspires to become a gold standard employer of choice for those living with MS, other neurological and autoimmune conditions and those who identify as carers.

To this end, MS Australia has undertaken a whole-of-organisation approach to support carers, family and friends of those living with MS and other neurological and autoimmune diseases in our day-to-day operations.

The MS Australia Carer Strategy is the result of a culmination of activities focussed on illuminating the voice and experience of carers in our governance, research, advocacy and education and awareness activities. This strategy will draw together and build on existing carer-focussed work. This project will form part of MS Australia's Consumer Engagement Roadmap.

2. THE FIVE PILLARS OF OUR CARER STRATEGY

MS Australia's three business units have a commitment to embedding carers, recognising that those affected by MS have unique experiences and separate needs that should be underpinned by a robust evidence base.



The Carer Strategy consists of five pillars:

- Focussed Research Agenda: MS Australia's research agenda features high-quality research projects, including a focus on the needs of carers that could facilitate translation and implementation of research outcomes for this cohort.
- Collaborate with Member Organisations: We acknowledge the valuable work that is already occurring within our Member Organisations (MO). MS Australia will collaborate further with our MOs to jointly meet the needs of carers.
- MS Australia Accredited Employer of Choice: Aspiring to be an employer of choice, we have embarked on a policy, operations and governance priority to become a gold standard employer for people with MS and other neurological and autoimmune diseases.
- Advocacy Agenda: We will ensure our advocacy, policy and education and awareness activities
 include separate resources, a web landing page and strengthening of collaborations with key
 peak bodies, such as Carers Australia.
- Enhance Carer Capacity: Ultimately, we would like to enhance carers' capacity through a range
 of activities, information provision and education, campaigns and improved access to resources
 that would improve a carers quality of life and capacity to navigate the various services
 systems.
